

CTSI TransPop Volunteer Registry FAQ

- **What is a registry?**
 - It is a secured directory of people (18 or older) who are willing to be contacted to participate in clinical research studies.
- **What does it mean to be registered in the registry?**
 - It means that you give us permission to contact you if we believe you might be a good fit for one of our studies. We will invite you to participate and you will decide if you want to participate or not.
- **Why are we looking for volunteers?**
 - Research takes a long time. Having a group of people willing to participate in research allows us to speed up our process of recruiting our community to improve health.
- **Who can register in the volunteer registry?**
 - Any person 18 or older can register.
- **Can participants of the MURDOCK Study register for this registry?**
 - Yes.
- **Is there any Zip code restriction?**
 - No. There is no zip code restriction.
- **How do I register for the volunteer registry?**
 - You need to enter your information at www.volunteer.duketranspop.org
- **Can I register by phone or using a paper form?**
 - No. Registration must be completed electronically.
- **Do you only need sick people?**
 - No. We need healthy participants as well as people suffering from a disease or condition.
- **Is there compensation?**
 - There is no compensation for registering in the registry. However, certain studies may offer compensation.
- **Will studies be done in Kannapolis?**
 - Yes. However, many studies can have multiple sites. It will depend on the study.

- **Will the volunteer registry be offered in other languages?**
 - Yes. The volunteer registry will also be offered in Spanish.
